- Communications operability is a critical building block for interoperability



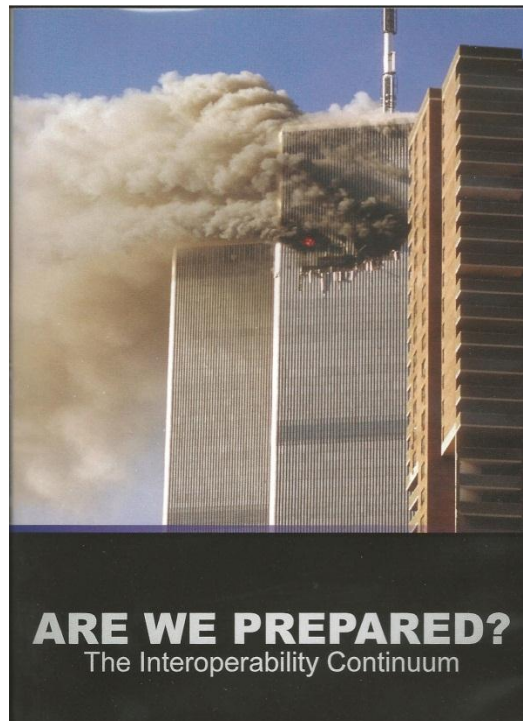
